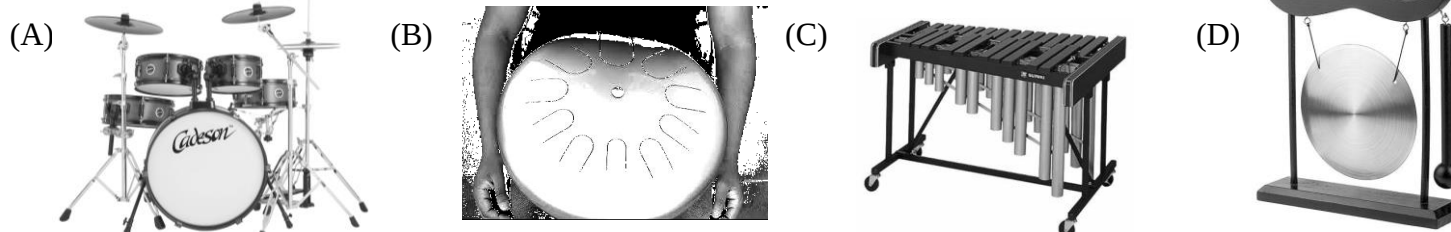

In 2007, an American, Dennis Havlena, made it with the bottoms of gas tanks. He picked two bottoms, put them together as a round UFO and cut many tongues on it. The tongues decide the notes. The sounds of tongue drums are soft and relaxing, so people often use them to make music for mind healing and meditation. 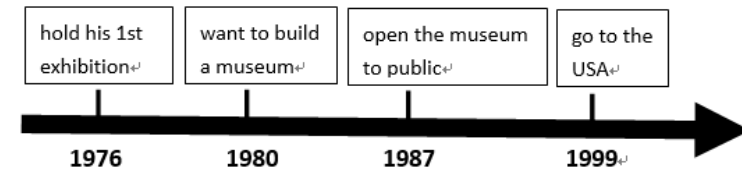
Ju Ming was born in 1938 in Miaoli. He started to learn wood-carving when he was fifteen years old. After the age of thirty, he followed the famous artist, YuYu Yang, as a pupil and started his way to modern art. In 1976, Ju Ming held his first exhibition and soon became well-known in Taiwan. But he didn't stop here. In 1980, he went to New York. During this time, his talent in art brought him full fruition in his career. In 1987, he made up his mind about building his own museum. After twelve years of hard work, Juming Museum started to open to the public in 1999. It was also the first private museum in Taiwan.

Juming Museum is different from others in Taiwan. You can see art both inside and outside the buildings. Every artwork fits perfectly with the green lawns, beautiful mountains, blue seas and clear sky in North Taiwan. The exhibitions there are interesting and meaningful. 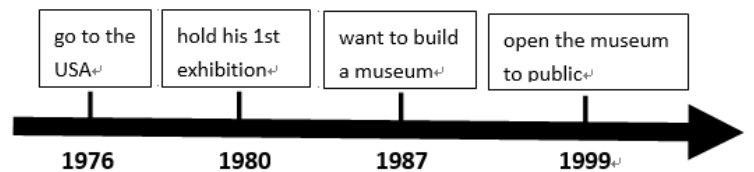

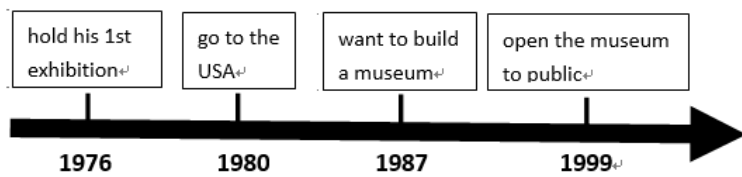

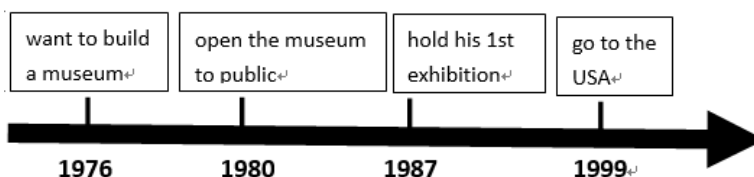
