“Wuhan Shake” Goes Virus

The new coronavirus, COVID-19, is changing the way people around the world say "hi". COVID-19 is usually spread when a person with the virus coughs, sneezes, or even breathes. Kobe Bryant, one of the best NBA players, died on Jan. 26, 2020. Bryant and his 13-year-old daughter, Gianna Bryant, were killed in a helicopter crash on the way to a basketball game at the Mamba Sports Academy. Seven other people also died in the crash. He had played for the Lakers for twenty years until 2016. He won five NBA championship titles, two Finals MVPs and one regular season MVP.

All the fans around the world were heartbroken when they heard this bad news. Fans miss all the things in his lifetime and one of them is his mamba mentality. For Bryant, mamba mentality was more than just basketball. The first part of mamba mentality is to believe in hard work. Without preparation and practice, you will fail. The second part of mamba mentality is never fear! You must try to do your best. Try to be better today than you were yesterday.

Many people believe in Bryant and follow his mamba mentality to keep going and fighting when they meet difficult situations. Although Kobe Bryant passed away, his mamba mentality will stay forever.

“If you’re afraid of fail, then you’re probably going to fail. Pain doesn’t tell you when you ought to stop. Pain is the little voice in your head that tries to hold your back because it knows if you continue you will change. The moment you give up is the moment you let someone win.”
