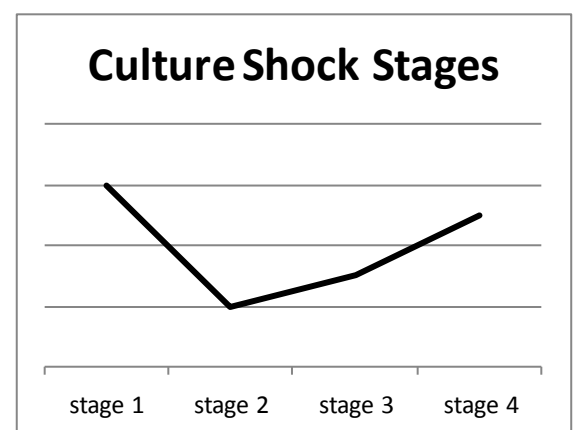

Culture shock is a common phenomenon. It usually happens on travelers, foreign students or people who move to other countries. It's the surprise of a new place, with new people and a new way of life. When people visit a new country and experience a new lifestyle, they might be excited at the beginning. However, they will soon find out living away from their own culture is not an easy thing. They may have headaches or always be in a bad mood. It takes time for people to deal with the bad feelings. A study shows that there are four stages of getting through culture shock.

At first, the culture shock begins with the honeymoon stage. New places and new lifestyles give us a sense of freshness. People are happy to learn more about new things. After some time, people will go into the next stage—frustration. At this stage, new things and lifestyles are not interesting anymore. Being away from family, friends and home makes people feel a little lost in the world. This is also the most difficult stage. Some people even give up living in a new country and go back home at this stage. If you get through the second stage, you will soon adjust to the new place. In the third adjustment stage, you will know that your life won't go back to what it was. So, you will try to enjoy yourself. Usually after months or years of struggling with the new things, you will go into the "acceptance stage"—feeling more comfortable in a new culture. Sometimes you may miss your old habits or your home but you can find a good balance between them.



Everyone has the chance to experience new cultures. If you find new things bring you a lot of trouble, don't be scared. You are just in one of the stages of culture shock. You will be fine after you find a way to live with them.
