Child labor is a big problem in Western Africa. There are more than 2 million children working on cocoa farms in Ivory Coast and Ghana. Those children are between 12 to 16 years old, and some are even younger. They work long hours and make less than 1 US dollar a day.

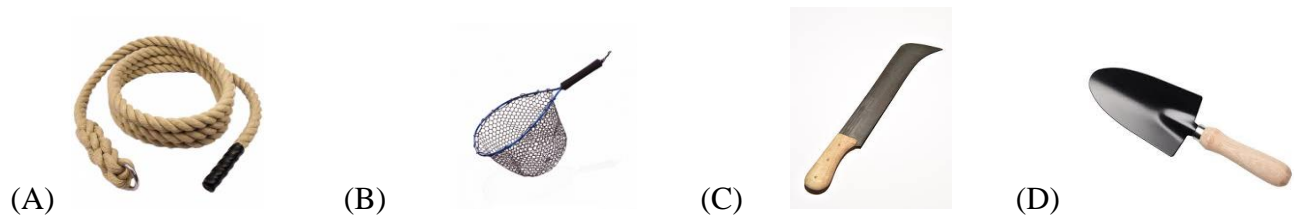
The working environment for the child labor is bad and not safe. They work over 12 hours a day. When they are working, they need to climb up the cocoa trees to cut the cocoa pods with machete—a large, sharp, heavy and dangerous knife. After they cut the pods from the trees, they put the pods into bags. Those bags are usually over 100 pounds and they need to carry them all the way through the forest. To take out the cocoa beans from the pod, those children have to hold a pod in one hand and use the machete to open it. They hurt themselves easily when doing so. Many of them have scars on their bodies because of their work on the cocoa farm.

Most of the the child workers in Ivory Coast don't have a chance to go to school. Some parents work hard on the cocoa farm for 30 years, but they can only let one of their children go to school. Little education can't make those children's lives better.

Now more and more people know the sad stories of the child labor. They are fighting for their rights. Let's join them and make a change.
