For most people, taking the MRT or shopping in a store may be easy. However, for those who are blind or cannot see very clearly, the everyday events can cause problems. For hundreds of years, many people have been working on technology that can help the blind. Today, there are more and more technologies that make their lives even more convenient.

Louis Braille was just a young boy when he lost his sight in a terrible accident. The young man created a language he could read with his fingers. At just 15 years old, Braille built the Braille System that the blind people still use today.


Lately, smartphone apps have become popular with those who have problems with their sights. One app called *Be My Eyes* connects a blind user to a volunteer who can help watch the video. The user can then point the camera at anything they need help with, and the volunteer becomes their eyes. This could help a blind person choose the right sandwich from a menu in a restaurant.

One company, called Aira, makes the technology go even further. Aira makes use of cameras attached to smart glasses like Google Glass. By watching the video from the camera on the smart glasses, the smart sight assistant can help them do anything they have troubles doing before.

Kobe Bryant

When US basketball star Kobe Bryant died in a helicopter crash, the whole basketball world stopped. Bryant, 41, and his 13-year-old daughter Gianna were traveling in a helicopter. Their helicopter ended up in fires and everyone on it was killed.

Bryant, who played for the Lakers, is one of the best players in the history of basketball. He was the 2008 NBA Most Valuable Player (MVP). He got the highest score twice and a two-time Olympic champion, too. He not only was a successful basketball player, but also won an Oscar with his short movie. Just five minutes long, this movie was about a love letter he had written to his sport back in 2015.

Bryant was famous for his hard work. When Kobe went to Lower Merin High School, he would show up to practice at 5 a.m. and leave at 7 a.m. – as a teenager. In his Laker days, Kobe was often the first player in the gym, even when he was hurt. He has been probably one of the most hard-working players in NBA history.
