Donald Trump Became President Again

Again, Donald Trump was chosen as the president of the United States. At age 78, he became the oldest person to be president. Trump won 295 votes, while Kamala Harris, lost with 226 votes. Harris, the vice president at the time, hoped to become the first woman and the first Black and South Asian American president, but she did not win.

Trump won important states like Wisconsin, North Carolina, Georgia, and Pennsylvania, and his win was celebrated by his fans across the country. After winning, Trump talked about his plans. He said he wanted the country to be “strong and safe.” He decided to make changes, such as protecting the country’s borders. He also thanked his fans for choosing him as the 45th and 47th president.

Trump **took office** in January 2025, while Harris left her job as vice president then. Trump’s vice president is JD Vance, a 40-year-old senator from Ohio. This brings a younger leader in the office. Some people were happy about Trump’s comeback, but others worried about the new changes he would make. His win shows that he still has many fans, even though people have different ideas about him.

When you first meet Anna, you may think she's strange. She often tells people which word "tastes" good and who has a "delicious" name. But she's not crazy. She has synesthesia. Only one in 2,000 people has this kind of experience.

If people have synesthesia, they experience the world differently. For some people, different words "taste" differently, for some, numbers or letters have colors, and for some, music "touches" parts of their bodies. Many of them experience more than one kind of synesthesia, but some have just one, like Anna.

Each of them has their own experience — two people with synesthesia may both "feel" music, but they almost never feel the music in the same way. For example, one may feel the music of the violin softly brushing his face; the other may feel it on her ankle. And one's experience of synesthesia is always the same. If they see the number 5 in the color blue, then every time they see 5, it is blue.

There's one thing about synesthesia: It can't be "turned off." If you have synesthesia, you'll experience it all the time. Anna met a man one day and his name made her think of the taste of bad eggs. He was a fun guy, but after thinking about his name all night, she felt too sick to be friends with him. Even so, she still likes this special talent because that's what makes her different.
