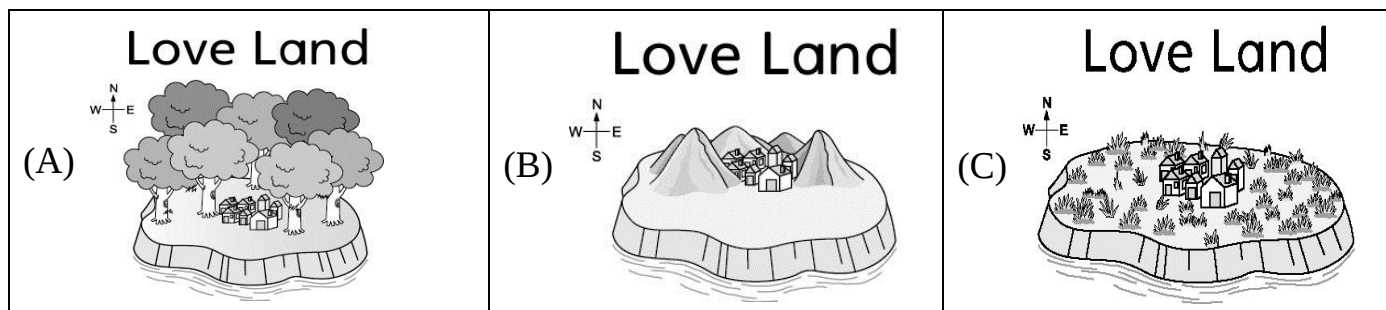

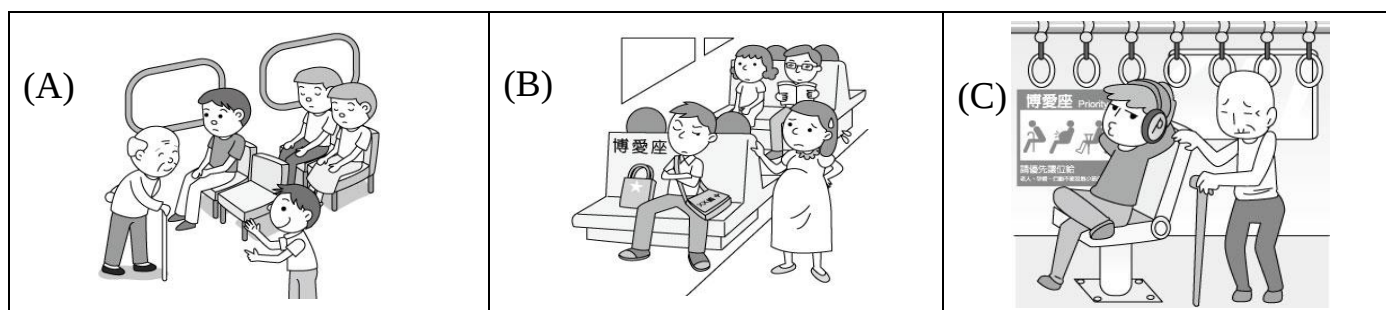

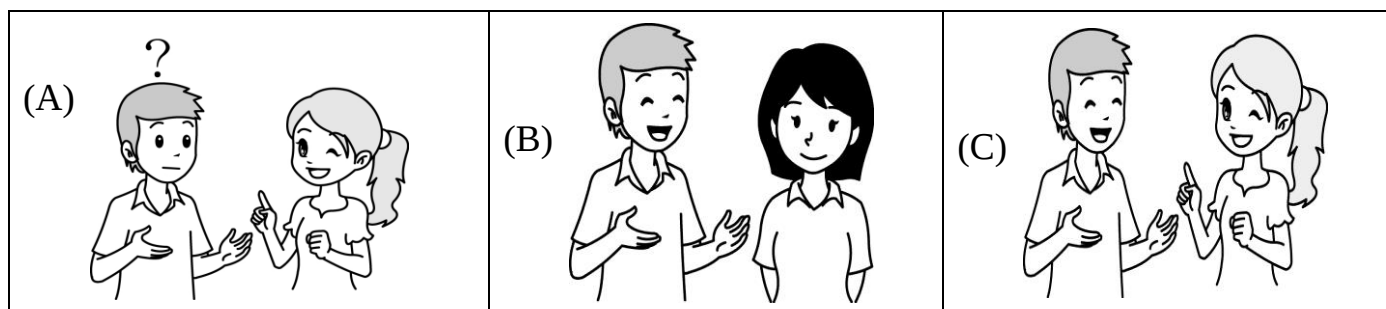

Have you ever seen dogs looking for food or sleeping on the street, beside a river, or in the mountains? Most of them might be stray dogs or dogs without homes.

In 2005, there were 128,473 stray dogs in Taiwan, and the number is still growing in some cities. Why are there so many stray dogs? A lot of them are **abandoned** by their owners. It might be because their owners are going to have a baby, and they are afraid that having a dog in their house might not be safe for their baby. Some owners give up their pet dogs because they are old or sick and no longer make good pets.

The problem of stray dogs is getting worse because they give birth to puppies each year. In fact, of all the stray dogs, only 10% are abandoned by their owners. However, on average, a mother dog can give birth to thirty dogs each year.

Things must be done to deal with the problem of stray dogs. For example, people should stop throwing away their pet dogs. If their pet dogs get lost, they should try their best to find them. If people want to have a pet dog, it would be better to adopt a stray dog. Once they get one, they should love it, take good care of it, and never let it go.
